OLD BUSINESS:

Memorial Scholarship:

The Memorial Scholarship was eventually phased into the East Foundation Internship. This change needs to be recorded in handbook. There was a suggestion by Michael Willson to combine names. Rainy Day Fund: Willy

Discussion about a recommendation to set up a separate investment account for Rainy Day Fund. Earns about 4%/year. Motion: Doug Tolleson To up separate investment account (Diversified Blue Chip) for Rainy Day Fund at \$45,000 and unrealized gain remains in fund and the income rolls over into money market. Will revisit plan every three years. Second: Bill Approved with no dissent.
